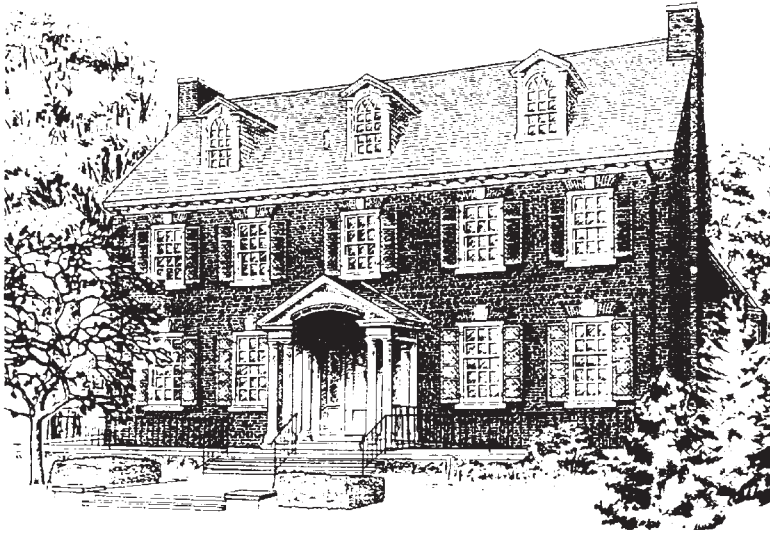

COUNT I—DIVORCE UNDER
SECTION 3301(c) OR 3301(d)
OF THE DIVORCE CODE

1. Plaintiff is Catherine Adhiambo, an adult individual of the age of 42, who resides at 745 South Woodward Street, Allentown, Lehigh County, Pennsylvania 18103, since 2007.

2. Defendant is Peter Normand Godbout, an adult individual of the age of 38, whose residence is unknown.

3. Plaintiff has been a bona fide resident in the Commonwealth for at least six (6) months immediately previous to the filing of this Complaint.

4. The Plaintiff and Defendant were married on March 14, 2005, in Springfield, Massachusetts.

5. There have been no prior actions of divorce or for annulment between the parties.

6. The Plaintiff has been advised of the availability of counseling and that the Plaintiff may have the right to request that the Court require the parties to participate in counseling.

7. Neither Plaintiff nor Defendant is presently a member of the armed forces.

8. Plaintiff avers that there are no children of the parties under the age of 18.

9. The parties to this action separated on December, 2005, and if divorce is sought under Section 3301(d) of the Divorce Code, the parties will have lived separately and apart for a period of at least two (2) years as the date of the 3301(d) Affidavit which will be filed by the Plaintiff.

10. There has been an irretrievable breakdown of the marriage of the parties within the meaning of the Divorce Code of 1980, as amended.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests that your Honorable Court to enter a Decree in Divorce.
